

2026 NMRRC Royalty Contest Application Cover Page

This contest will be held on **Friday, April 24th** at the NMRRC National Show and is open to all NMRRC youth members. The contest consists of a formal Application submitted ahead of time, written test on general rabbit knowledge and breed specific information, variety identification contest, and for the two older age divisions you must complete two scored judging contests. The younger two age divisions must compete in the showmanship. Along with those you must complete one of the following: Photo, Craft, or Educational Display/Poster Contests. You may compete in other contests, but only one of these three can be used for this application. Those with the top scores will be called back for an interview. This cover page and application must be filled out completely to be accepted.

Application: Respond to the following questions on your own paper in five pages or less, excluding this cover page and your biography (Question #15). Application may be handwritten or typed using 10-12 point reader friendly font. Include your name at the top of each page. Answer each question separately in the order listed below. This will be judged on the following criteria: Size and Scope of Project (10 pts); Purpose, Goals & Future Plans (15 pts); Management (20 pts); Achievement (20 pts); Leadership (20 pts); Clarity, Thoroughness of Answers and Neatness of Application (15 pts).

1. When did you join the NMRRC and how many consecutive years have you been a member?
2. How and when did you get started in your project? Who has helped you the most with this project?
3. What are your goals this year for your project?
4. List your membership in all rabbit related clubs, and offices/committees you've been involved with.
5. What offices have you held, or committees have you served on in local, state or national rabbit clubs?
6. Name the varieties of Mini Rex that you have raised. Which is your favorite variety and why?
7. Describe your housing, equipment and herd management. Be specific.
8. What specifically do you do to help with the care and upkeep of your project?
9. Describe the records you keep and how you keep them.
10. List the outstanding awards and achievements that both you and your rabbits have earned.
11. What have you done to promote the Mini Rex as a breed and make others aware of your project?
12. How have you been a leader in your project?
13. How do you think that your project will help you in your future endeavors?
14. What would you like for us to know that has not already been asked?
15. On a separate page write a short description of your achievements that can be printed in the NMRRC Newsletter, if you win this contest. Write what you would like to be printed in 400 words or less.
This does not count toward the page count, but failure to include this question will result in a 20 point deduction in the application score.
16. Include one photo you would like to use to be put in the Newsletter, if you win this contest.
